

Meetings

Throughout its history the Managers have held regular monthly meetings. In the early days, 1966 – 1968, the Managers' Meetings were usually held in the basement of the Graystone Manor Hotel. Beginning in 1969, and continuing until 1981, most meetings were held in Rogstad-Cherry dental offices at 1136 Washington Ave (later Dental Building). (The District began paying rent to the Dental Building at the rate of \$10 per month in 1974, later raised to \$30 per month in 1979). Other meeting venues included City Council Chambers, the County Court House, KDLM, and the Larson Engineering Associates building.

Starting in 1981, and continuing through 1994, nearly all of the regular Manager meetings were held at the Larson Engineering Associates building at 522 Main Street I Detroit Lakes (also known as the Engineer's Office, and Larson-Peterson Associates). Special meetings were held at the Holiday Inn, and at various other public venues. Some meetings were held in private homes in association with pontoon inspection trips around District Lakes. Office space was provided by Rural Minnesota CEP after 1990.

From 1994 to 1998, the official meeting place was changed to the City Council Chambers in order to provide more access to the public. In 1998, the District secured office space at 801 Roosevelt, and began to hold its official meetings there.
