

# PELICAN RIVER WATERSHED DISTRICT

## ENGINEER'S MONTHLY REPORT

June 2010

### 1. Permit Activity

**Lori Avenue Bridge:** The proposed project involves the reconstruction of the Lori Avenue Bridge. Following completion, approximately 0.24 acres will be converted to impervious area. The project is located on Lori Avenue at the Pelican River. The initial application was received on April 5, 2010. The MnDNR issued comments regarding the design of the new culverts (bridge) and reported on June 18 that all comments were addressed during construction.

Recommendation: Issue permit (as of 6/11/10)

**North Washington Avenue Reconstruction:** The proposed project involves the reconstruction of 1,466 linear feet of Washington Avenue between Main Street and Highway 34. Following completion, approximately 2.22 acres will be converted to impervious area. Stormwater runoff will be treated by expanding two existing ponds. The initial application was received on April 13, 2010 with additional information submitted on June 9, 2010.

Recommendation: Issue permit (as of 6/9/10)

**Zorbaz:** The proposed project involves a 2,800 sf building addition, removing much of a gravel parking lot, and installation of a sedimentation basin and subsurface infiltration system. It is not known how many acres of the site will be converted to impervious area following completion. The project is located at the northwest corner of West Lake Drive and Summit Avenue. The initial application was received on May 18, 2010.

Recommendation: Issue permit with conditions (as of 5/25/10)
