

## Ice Ridge Repair

Only sand and gravel may be sloped towards the lake. All slopes regarded towards the lake must be covered with riprap or bio-erosion control.

A lip at least 8 inches higher than the lot shall remain to reduce runoff into the lake. The 8-inch difference shall be measured between the ridge top and 3 feet landward of the ridge.

All disturbed areas must be protected against erosion by seeding, sodding, other vegetation, or riprap.

Trees lost due to the ice push should be replaced to protect the shore and reduce future expenses due to erosion.

Stumps remaining from trees lost to the push should be ground. The roots should not be excavated.

Incompliance with the Wetlands Conservation Act of 1991, soil removed from the ice ridge must not be placed into a wetland.
